Course Overview:

This course is designed to enable the international students to develop the listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in Japanese at a beginner level of foreigners. Moreover, the students will be able to learn basic Japanese grammar, sentence structure, polite expressions, titles, tenses, vocabulary in daily life, and common basic conversation on topics related to Japanese culture.

Course Objective:

1. Understand a basic Japanese communicative situation. Example; introduce themselves to others, greeting and everyday conversation with related daily life in Japanese culture.
2. To familiarize basic vocabulary, expressions and interact with simple sentences.
