Individual Presentation

The theme of 2014 Global Cultural Engagement Convention is "Cultural Diversity: Global Leadership in 21st Century". The Convention invites participant to share their experiences and insight in promoting cultural integration as a student leader. To gain better understanding about the challenges and missions to be a Global Leader in the present world, we encourage presentations that can integrate the conference them one focus areas as listed below:

1. Student Integration on Campus

- introduce the works of promoting internationalization in your own institutes
- share what you have learn in participating international program
- give suggestions to enhance integration on Campus

2. Strategies of Enhancing Internationalization as Student Group

- share your experience in organizing activities for international students
- challenges and difficulties that encountered
- role and importance of student group in promoting student integration

3. Developing Global Leadership

- share your personal growth in cultivating leadership skills
- effective ways and strategies for developing student leadership
- the role as global leader in 21st century

Participant will be given <u>15 minutes</u> to present their topic under one of the suggested fields, <u>and 20mins</u> <u>Q & A session</u> alongside with other presenters in one session. Please submit a <u>400-word abstract</u> for your presentation before <u>6^h June 2014</u> for convention secretariat consideration. Selected presentation will be announced on <u>10th June 2014</u> and all successful application will be given subsidy of <u>USD\$100</u> for their efforts.

Group Project Competition

The aim of Global Cultural Engagement Convention is to enhance the understanding toward each other with different background, and to obtain some concrete, feasible events for cultural integration in universities. Therefore, we would like to encourage students to explore some issues with different perceptions and suggest some event proposals as the followings:

Projects on Body Language & Gender Role & Humor & Food

Different countries have different views in gender role and there are some gender role issues in the world. It is a precious opportunity for us to investigate and study the gap from different views on gender role. In order to understand more the difference of people, the body language is the one of the topics to discuss. Each race has their own body language and tradition behavior such as food and humor so it is interesting to explore our difference in how to express ourselves in daily life.

Event Proposals on how to enhance the integration and understanding between each other

Regarding to encourage the cultural integration, more efforts have to been done. Students can make good use of their creativity and experience to initiate some event proposals on these topics and present it to other students. It is a wonderful platform for us to brainstorm and share what we do after the convention.

Participant will be given 15 minutes to present their topic under one of the suggested fields, and 15 mins Q & A session alongside with other presenters in one session. The best group will be awarded in the closing ceremony.

Subsidy for Participants
