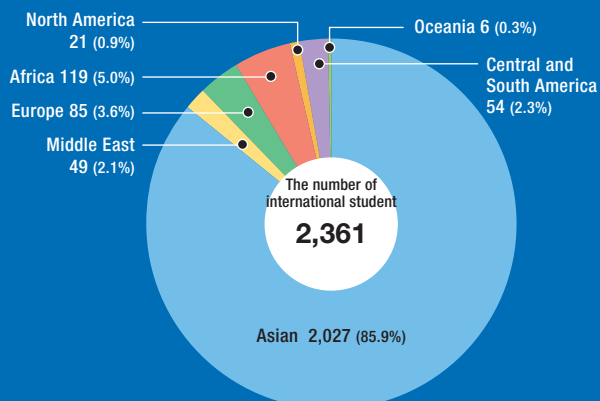

LIVING in FUKUOKA and CAMPUSES

■ Living in Fukuoka ■

A pleasant coastal city of 1.6 million people and the largest metropolis on the island of Kyushu, Fukuoka is Japan's gateway to continental Asia. China and Korea are both close by—the city lies midway between Tokyo, Shanghai, and Seoul—and life here still reflects an ancient heritage of cultural exchange. At the same time the city enjoys a growing reputation as a modern, vibrant regional trade and production center. Recently, the New York Times ranked Fukuoka 19th on its list of “52 Places to Go in 2023”.

Host to national and prefectural government offices, and to the regional headquarters of many major companies, Fukuoka is Kyushu's most active, and largest, business center. China, Korea, and the United States have established consulates in the city, too. With thirteen major universities and 73,000 students, Fukuoka is noted as a city of youthful verve and fashion. Also, all parts of the urban area are easily accessible by subway, bus, or bicycle. Fukuoka is a safe and secure place to live in like other cities in Japan.

■ Kyushu and beyond ■

A land of mountains, hot springs, and historic treasures, Kyushu has always been at the center of Japan's cultural contacts with the world outside. You can take advantage of winter and spring breaks to explore the island or other parts of Japan, while Korea and China are just a short trip away by hydrofoil or plane. It's a great way to deepen your understanding of this fascinating part of Asia.

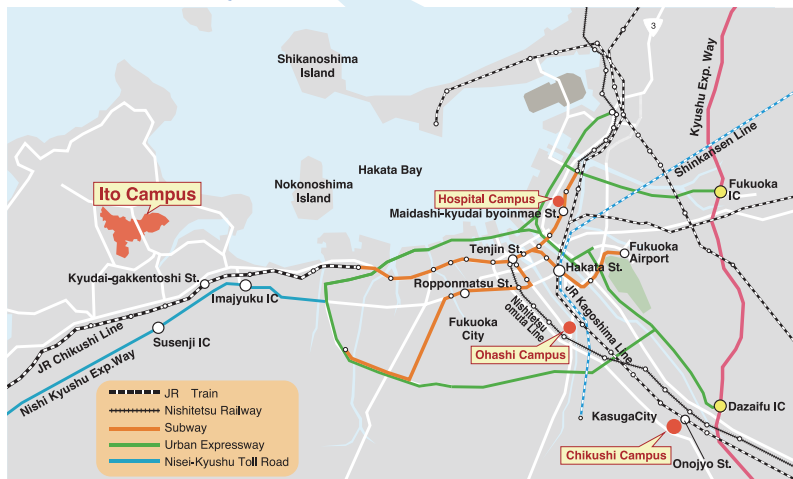

福岡市について

九州最大の都市であり、160万人の人口を抱える福岡市は、日本におけるアジア大陸へのゲートウェイです。東京、上海、ソウルの間に位置し、中国と韓国にも近く、古くからの文化交流の伝統が息づいていると同時に、近代的で活気のある地域貿易・生産の中心地としても高い評価を得ています。最近ではニューヨークタイムズ紙が、福岡市を「2023年に行くべき52の場所」の中で19位に選出しました。

国や県庁、多くの大企業の本社が集まる福岡市は、九州で最も活発なビジネスの中心地で、中国、韓国、アメリカなどの領事館も設置されています。13の大学と7万3千人の学生を擁しており、若者の活気とファッションの街としても注目されています。また、地下鉄、バス、自転車など交通の便がよく、都市部のどこへでも簡単にアクセスできます。日本のその他の都市と同様に治安が良く安全で、安心して生活できる街です。

1. How to Apply

STEP 1

You are required to be nominated as applicants officially from your university to Kyushu University. Please make sure with the international office of your university about the internal deadline and required documents firstly as it depends on each university. (We DO NOT accept applications directly from individual students.)

STEP 2

You are required to complete the application via online submission system by the designated deadline if you are selected as a nominee by your home university. The relevant instruction will be sent from Kyushu University accordingly.

STEP 3

The result will be notified approximately 3 months before your enrollment. You will receive a notification regarding a procedure for visa issuance and accommodation along with the letter of acceptance if you pass the screening.

2. Eligibilities

Applicants have to meet the following eligibilities.

- Must have studied at least 1 year in the degree program of home university.
- Required GPA 3.2/4.0
- Language Proficiency
For those who study in Japanese: JLPT N1 or equivalent
*JLPT N2 would be acceptable for JLCC/Q-PELS.
For those who study in English: TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0 or equivalent

1. 申請方法

ステップ 1

まずは、所属大学から九州大学への正式な推薦が必要です。学内締切日や必要書類については、大学によって異なりますので、まずは所属大学の関係部署に確認してください。
(所属大学を通さずに、直接申請をすることはできません。)

ステップ 2

所属大学から正式に推薦されたら、指定された期日までに、九州大学のオンライン申請システムで出願を完了していただく必要があります。オンライン申請に関する案内は、適宜お知らせします。

ステップ 3

選考の結果については受入れ開始時期の約3ヶ月前にお知らせします。受入れが可となった方には、合格通知とともにビザの発給手続きやドミトリーの入居申請に関する案内が届きます。

Overviews

JTW is an ideal program for your year exchange if you are looking for an opportunity to learn about contemporary Japanese culture and society, both academically and experientially, while not having Japanese proficiency. JTW enables you to extensively study at one of Japan's top universities located in one of the most popular cities across the country. This is an English-taught program, but it also offers you the opportunity to start learning or to further hone your Japanese language skills for credit through the University's renowned Japanese program. JTW runs for 10 months, starting in October and ending in July the following year. You are also welcome to join for only one semester, either Fall-Winter (Oct.-Feb.) or Spring-Summer (Apr.-Jul.).

JTW offers you a comprehensive package of living and learning experiences including cultural immersion for experiential learning as well as academic learning for credit. Students of any academic majors are welcome; you may create a portfolio of study suited to your interests across a broad range of courses, projects, and activities. JTW is a diverse group of about 50 students coming from leading universities all over the world, and the program coordinators – university faculty members with a rich background in international education and research – work closely with you. A JTW tutor, your own Japanese student partner, will be on hand to help you throughout your stay.

Academic Programs

As a JTW student, per semester you will be required to enroll in a minimum of six credit-awarding courses as overviewed below.

JTW Core Courses – The core of JTW’s academic learning component, which address a range of topics in Japanese Studies, including courses on history, literature, popular culture, economics, business, education, law, religion, and politics, among others. All the courses are taught in English by enthusiastic instructors from a variety of faculties at Kyushu University. Each JTW student is required to enroll in at least two JTW core courses per semester. (2 credits/course; 3 credits negotiable)

Japanese Language Courses – Kyushu University’s Japanese Academic Courses (JACs), which offers eight levels of comprehensive Japanese language instruction, from beginning to advanced. There are also skill-specific courses on writing, speaking, and kanji. Per semester, each course consists of two quarters (7.5-week sessions per quarter), and each session is run as an intensive, small group, practical session. Up to three JACs courses may be counted toward fulfilling the JTW enrollment requirement. (2 credits/course)

Independent Study Project (ISP) – An optional, semester-long, self-driven research project to carry out within the field of or closely related to Japanese studies of your interest. Your ISP is supervised by a University faculty member who is arranged by the JTW program, and toward the end of a semester you are required to present the findings both in written and oral forms. Only one ISP is counted toward fulfilling the six courses enrollment requirement. (2 credits/course)

Advanced Laboratory Research (ALR) – Another optional research opportunity for you to design and carry out a research project at advanced levels in engineering, general science, agriculture, or pharmacy. You will plan and carry out an intensive laboratory research project under the guidance of a faculty specialist in the relevant area. An ALR counts as two courses toward fulfilling the six courses enrollment requirement. (2 credits/semester)

Regular Faculty Courses – Courses offered by regular faculties outside JTW – such as Literature, Law, Economics, Design, Science, Engineering, etc. – and primarily for their respective degree-seeking students. Through JTW, you may enroll in some of these external courses except for postgraduate courses. Up to three regular faculty courses may be counted toward fulfilling the six courses enrollment requirement. (2 credits/semester)

Experiential Learning Activities

JTW uniquely provides the following resources and opportunities for your experiential learning of history and contemporary culture and day-to-day social life in Japan.

JTW Field Study Trips – Over the course of a program year, JTW carries out a total of 11-13 field study trips roughly at a once-a-month pace. Most trips will take you somewhere in the northern part of Kyushu Island, including Nagasaki. Some trips involve physical activities such as rice reaping and planting, seated meditation at a Buddhist temple, and interacting with local elementary school students in their classrooms. Students are required to cover a small part of the expenses.

Home Visit Program – If interested, you will be introduced to a Japanese family living in the Fukuoka City area, typically with school-age children. Your host family will host you on periodic weekend visits to their home and may take you out to popular local sites and events. Some students end up staying with more than one host family and developing warm friendships that last well beyond their program participation period.

Student Tutors – JTW provides you with a student supporter, a JTW Tutor, who is typically Japanese and offers you one-on-one assistance. Your Tutor will help you to settle in, explore Fukuoka City with you, accompany you on program outings, and arrange informal parties and trips.

Ito Campus

Two types of Japanese language curricula are available at Ito Campus as described below, and exchange students may choose courses based on their circumstances and needs including their proficiency levels, interest in earning credits, and time-availability to focus on the language learning, among others.

1. Japanese Academic Courses (JACs)

日本語アカデミックコース

JACs are for students who want to earn credits in Japanese language. These courses consist of four types – comprehensive Japanese, kanji, conversation, and composition – and offer up to eight levels of learning, ranging from absolute beginners to advanced learners.

JACsは、日本語の単位を取得したい留学生のためのコースで、総合日本語、漢字、会話、作文の4つのコースから構成されています。クラスは8つのレベルに分かれており、全くの初心者から上級者までが学習できる授業内容を提供しています。

2. Japanese Training Courses (JTCs)

日本語課外補講コース

JTCs are for training purposes, not for credit, offered primarily to graduate students, research students, and exchange students at both undergraduate and graduate levels. Through JTCs, comprehensive Japanese courses are offered from Level 1 up to Level 7 (from absolute beginners to advanced learners). JTCs are recommended to exchange students who are interested in taking Japanese language courses but are not in need of earning credit in those courses.

JTCsは、主に大学院生、研究生、交換留学生(学部・大学院レベル)を対象にした、単位取得を目的としないコースです。レベル1からレベル7までの全くの初心者から上級者までを対象とした、総合的な日本語の授業を提供しています。日本語は学習したいが単位取得の必要はないという交換留学生の方にお勧めです。

■ 1. Estimated Living Expenses in Fukuoka / 福岡市での生活費の目安 ■

Living costs are significantly reasonable in Fukuoka compared to other big cities, such as Tokyo, Osaka and Nagoya. You will need between 80,000 and 115,000 yen a month to live in depending on your dormitory room choice and habitual use of water and electricity, which varies greatly between individuals.

福岡での生活費は、東京、大阪、名古屋などの大都市と比べるとかなり安価です。個人差はありますが、寮の部屋のタイプや、水道・電気の使用量などによって、だいたい1ヶ月に8万円から11万5千円程度がかかります。

■ 2. Scholarship / 奨学金 ■

Most major scholarship for exchange students is JASSO (Japan Student Services Organization) scholarship. Applicants may apply for along with the Kyushu University exchange application procedures. 80,000 yen/month will be granted as a financial support for your student life in Kyushu if you are selected as a recipient. (The number of recipients differs depending on year /semester.)

If you apply for JLCC (Japanese Language and Culture Course), you may be eligible for MEXT (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) Scholarship.

交換留学生の方にとって、最もメジャーな奨学金は、日本学生支援機構(JASSO)奨学金です。九州大学への交換留学生申請の際に、併せて応募することができます。奨学生に選ばされると、交換留学中の生活費を支援するため、月額80,000円が支給されます。(支給人数は年度や学期によって異なります)。

また、JLCC(日本語・日本文化研修コース)への申請者は、文部科学省奨学金(国費外国人留学生奨学金)への応募が可能な場合もあります。

■ 3. Accommodation / 住居 ■

Kyushu University has six dormitories for international students. There are four dormitories in Ito campus and one dormitory in Ohashi and Hospital(Maidashi) campus respectively, which are quite reasonable. Single dorm room is guaranteed for each exchange student.

You are required to obtain "Student Visa" issued by Japanese embassy/consulate in your country of residence in order to study as an exchange student. Kyushu University will help you complete the required procedure for visa application as well as for dormitory using "Pre-Arrival Assistance" system.
