

## Frequently Asked Questions for Incoming JTW Students



I've been informed that I'm a successful applicant of JTW program. When Will I be able to receive the admission package, including the acceptance letter, academic calendar, academic guidelines, and course selection?

The acceptance letter will be sent to you approximately 2.5~3 months before your semester abroad starts.

When will I receive information about the CoE and necessary documents for the student visa?

You will receive all of this information from the Student Support Team ([imm.s@jimu.kyushu-u.ac.jp](mailto:imm.s@jimu.kyushu-u.ac.jp)) about 2.5 months before your semester abroad starts.



How do I apply for university dormitory?

You will receive details about 2 months before the start of the semester. JTW students are often allocated to Dormitory I or II. Dormitory allocations are done by the administrative office. As long as you submit your application by the deadline, you will be allocated a room.



When will the program orientation be held?

There are two orientations for JTW students. The first one is usually held online about 1.5 months before the semester starts. The second one will be held offline on campus 2-4 days before the semester starts.



Is there WiFi available at the dormitory and on campus?

Yes, free WiFi is available at the common areas in your dormitory during the day. To use WiFi or LAN internet, be sure to fill in the application form that you receive from the dorm manager after arriving. In order to use WiFi, you will need to buy a router from COOP shops on campus or from the electronic appliance shops nearby. To use the free WiFi on campus (<https://www.nc.kyushu-u.ac.jp/en/kitenet-en/?#manual>), you will need to activate your SSO-KID first. Your SSO-KID will be sent to you during the week before your semester starts via email.
